1. International Airport "Sandro Pertini" Caselle - City of Torino

Direct connection

Non-stop flights to Torino from principal European destinations.

Getting to the airport:

- By car – Torino airport is 16km from the city centre, from which it is reachable by car in approximately 25 minutes using the ring road connected to the motorway network.
- By train – a railway line connects Caselle airport with Dora GTT Station in Torino (www.gtt.to.it). Departures every 30 minutes. Journey time: 19 minutes.
- By bus – the centre of Torino is easily reachable in 40 minutes using the SADEM bus service (www.sadem.it).
- By taxi – the taxi area is located at the exit of the arrivals terminal; in addition to the public service there is a personalized limousine/taxi service operational 24 hours. Approximate fare: €35.

2. Milano Malpensa International Airport

Getting to the airport:

- By car - from Torino: A4 Milano-Torino motorway, exit Novara, S.S. (national road) 32, direction Oleggio, follow the directions for Malpensa. From Alessandria/Genoa: A26 motorway, exit Sesto Calende, direction Somma Lombardo, follow the directions for Malpensa.
- By bus – daily connections with Torino (www.sadem.it), journey time 2 hours approximately.

TRAIN

Piemonte's railway system has more than 2,000 km. Piemonte's central location in relation to the most important European rail connections is also reinforced by the high speed line, already partly operational, which will be completed in the next few years.
